

Program Participation & Tuition Agreement (A5)

Good Days Adolescent Special Needs Center, LLC – Fort Myers, FL

This Program Participation & Tuition Agreement (A5) (“Agreement”) sets forth the terms and conditions under which the program participant named below is participating in Good Days Adolescent Special Needs Center, LLC (“GDC”). By signing this Agreement, the Parent/Guardian acknowledges understanding of, and agreement to, all policies, responsibilities, payment terms, liability provisions, and expectations described herein.

Section 1. Program Commitment

Program Participation at Good Days Adolescent Special Needs Center constitutes a reservation of a limited, structured placement within our life skills training program. Due to the individualized nature of services and staffing ratios, enrollment is secured for a defined period and is not based on daily attendance.

Section 2: Program Overview

Good Days Adolescent Special Needs Center provides year-round, individualized life skills training integrated with therapeutic supports designed to promote independence and personal growth. Participation includes partaking in core daily programming, supervised activities, and therapeutic components as deemed appropriate by GDC staff.

Section 3: Tuition and Fees

Tuition is charged for the reservation of a placement and is not contingent upon attendance. No reductions, credits, or refunds are provided for absences, vacations, illness, or voluntary non-attendance.

Tuition is due quarterly in advance. Any scholarship reimbursements received may be applied as a credit toward the family's account, but do not replace the obligation for timely payment.

Annual Tuition: \$29,000 (based on full-year enrollment; subject to change with thirty (30) days' written notice).

Tuition Payment Options (it is recommended that you visit our website and choose "Pricing Plans" to complete your enrollment purchase:

- Annual payment in full (\$29,000)
- Quarterly installments of \$7,250.00 due on the 1st of each quarter
- Part-time annual payment (\$17,400)
- Part-time quarterly payment (\$4,350)
- Alternative payment plan (if approved by Owner and Director)

A non-refundable registration fee of \$250 is due at the time of submitting your application. The registration fee includes on-site assessment, onboarding, intake, scheduling, administrative set-up, transition planning, and initial staff preparation and training. Scholarship monies may NOT be used for the registration fee. Tuition includes participation in scheduled programming and standard supplies. Special events, field trips, or additional therapies may incur separate fees with prior notice.

Section 4: Payment Terms

A deposit equal to one (1) month of tuition is required at the time of acceptance into the program. The deposit will be held by Good Days Center and applied toward the final month of the participant's final enrollment period, provided all required withdrawal notice provisions of this agreement have been satisfied. Failure to provide proper written notice as outlined in this agreement may result in forfeiture of the

deposit. The deposit may also be applied toward any unpaid tuition, fees, damages, or outstanding balances owed to Good Days Center.

Tuition payments are due on or before the first day of each quarterly enrollment period. Quarterly enrollment periods begin January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1 of each calendar year. In situations where full quarterly scholarship funds are not immediately available through the *Step Up for Students Scholarship* program, Good Days Center may permit monthly tuition payments without additional finance charges until scholarship funds become available.

A \$50 late fee applies to tuition payments not received within five (5) calendar days of the applicable quarterly due date.

Returned payments incur a \$38 service charge. These charges are the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian, and no scholarship monies may be used to pay for late fees or service charges of any kind. Continued non-payment may result in suspension or termination of enrollment.

Payments may be made by check, ACH transfer, or approved scholarship funding. Families remain responsible for any remaining balance.

Section 5: Refund and Withdrawal Policy

All program participants require a minimum initial commitment of three (3) months. Following the initial commitment period, program participation will automatically renew in recurring three (3) month participation periods unless terminated in accordance with this agreement.

A written 30-day notice of withdrawal is required prior to the start of the next participation period. If a participant withdraws prior to the completion of the current participation period, tuition for the remainder of that participation period shall remain due and payable.

Registration fees are non-refundable.

Good Days Center may, at its sole discretion, consider partial refunds under extraordinary circumstances. Any approved refund shall be reduced by outstanding balances, fees, or charges.

Tuition remains due and payable throughout the notice period regardless of attendance. Consistent participation is considered an important component of continuity, routine, and meaningful progress within the program.

Section 6: Attendance and Schedule

Consistent attendance is essential for program effectiveness. Parents/guardians must notify the Center in advance of absences or schedule changes. Repeated unexcused absences may result in review of continued program participation.

Section 7: Policies and Conduct

Participation requires adherence to all Center policies, including safety, conduct, communication, and participation requirements outlined in the Parent Handbook. GDC reserves the right to discontinue program participation, whose behavior or needs cannot be safely accommodated.

Section 8: Photo/Video Release

- I GIVE permission for my child's photo/video to be used for internal and promotional purposes.
- I DO NOT GIVE permission for my child's photo/video to be used for any purpose.

Section 9: Emergency and Medical Consent

I authorize GDC staff to provide basic first aid and to contact emergency medical services as necessary. I accept full financial responsibility for any medical evaluation or treatment provided.

Section 10: Assumption of Risk

I understand that participation in GDC programs involves activities that may carry inherent risks, including but not limited to physical activity,

outdoor movement, use of equipment, and interactions with peers. I acknowledge and accept these risks on behalf of my child.

Section 11: Release of Liability; Hold Harmless Agreement

To the fullest extent permitted by Florida law, I hereby release, indemnify, and hold harmless Good Days Adolescent Special Needs Center, LLC, its owners, directors, officers, staff, employees, agents, and volunteers from any and all liability, claims, damages, injuries, or expenses arising from my child's participation in the program, except in cases of gross negligence or intentional misconduct.

Section 12: Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

The Parent/Guardian agrees to:

- Provide accurate and updated medical, behavioral, and contact information.
- Ensure timely payment of all tuition and fees.
- Support Center policies and expectations.
- Provide transportation.
- Follow illness guidelines.

Section 13: Contractual Term; Termination

This Agreement remains in effect for the duration of the program participant's enrollment. GDC may terminate enrollment for non-payment, safety concerns, policy violations, or if the participant's needs can no longer be safely or appropriately accommodated within the scope of services offered.

Section 14: Re-Enrollment Policy

Families who withdraw and later request re-enrollment are subject to:

- Availability of placement
- A new intake review
- A re-enrollment fee of \$1,000.00
- Updated enrollment documentation

Prior enrollment does not guarantee future placement.

Section 15: Scholarship Disclaimer

Participation in scholarship programs, including Step Up For Program participants, does not alter the parent/guardian's financial responsibility under this agreement. Any delays, reductions, or interruptions in scholarship funding do not relieve the obligation to pay tuition in full.

Section 16: Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is deemed unenforceable, the remainder of the Agreement remains in effect.

Section 17: Entire Agreement

This Agreement, together with the Parent Handbook, constitutes the entire understanding between the parties. Modifications must be in writing and signed by both parties.

Section 18: Governing Law

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Florida.
